# Trip and Road Rules

## **Bus/Van Rules:**

1. The driver is the king/queen. Never bother or interfere with the driver while the bus/van is in motion. Also, obey any requests or directions given by any adult leaders (quiet, directions, etc.).
2. Nothing is to go out of the windows (trash, wrappers, arms, legs, obnoxious people, etc.).
3. Don't complain. We are part of a group. We may not do things exactly the way you want or the way your family does. Don't be a whiner.
4. Inappropriate touch between sexes will not be permitted. Lap sitting, spit swapping, all the rest of that junk is not permitted. Respect yourself and others.
5. You will be responsible for leaving the bus/van as clean as when you entered the bus/van.

## **Other Rules:**

1. Any use of illegal or improper drug use, and any type of alcoholic beverage will be grounds for immediate dismissal and a return home at the expense of the offender or the offender's family/guardian. The offender will immediately be removed from the group and will need to be picked up within 12 hours.
2. Any defiant behavior, stealing, fighting, inappropriate touching, breaking curfew or leaving the group without permission is prohibited. This may also result in immediate dismissal and a return home at the expense of the offender's family/guardian. The offender will immediately be removed from the group and will need to be picked up within 12 hours.
3. All students are required to attend all meetings and other planned activities unless excused by Mike Regimbal. Exceptions will be given only in the case of emergency or illness. In case of illness, the afflicted person will be asked to use the following free time for rest and recuperation.
4. No one is allowed to leave our group to join another individual or group without permission from an adult.
5. No loners. You must be with at least one other person from our group at all times during this trip.
6. Don't do anything that could ruin or damage anyone's possessions, clothing, or bedding. No jokes involving substances like shaving cream, toothpaste, etc.
7. No girls in guys rooms... EVER. No guys in girls rooms ... EVER! No exceptions.
8. Curfews and lights out are to be observed by all students.
9. Your money and belongings are your own responsibility. FCC is not responsible should any item be misplaced or stolen.

## **Music Device Rule:**

No music/music listening devices of any kind are to be taken on this trip. Violation of this rule can result in permanent disposal of the devices or material (To be very clear about that, when you sign this form, it means you understand what you just read). Leave all music and music listening devices at home or learn an expensive lesson. Adult leaders will have plenty of music for the trip. You are welcome to suggest or provide music to adult leaders prior to the trip.

## **Cell Phone Rule:**

There are also to be NO CELL PHONES taken by students on this trip. Parents will have a list of adult leader cell phones in case of emergency. You can also use an adult leader's cell phone to make emergency calls. We will have plenty of cell phones if you need to make an emergency call. Violation of this rule can result in permanent disposal of the cell phone (To be very clear about that, when you sign this form, it means you understand what you just read). Leave all cell phones at home or learn an expensive lesson.

## **Explanation of Music Device and Cell Phone Rule:**

You have a unique opportunity to go on this trip. We want you to relax and enjoy your time away. We all need to "slow down" from our hectic lives once in a while, it's healthy. We want you to maximize your experience on this trip, an experience where you have the opportunity to build healthy relationships with other students and to improve your relationship with God. Therefore, we don't want students listening to headphones, texting, etc. when they could be talking to other human beings on this trip. We believe this will make you a better friend and person and will allow you to "slow down" your normal pace... and maybe you'll hear something from God.

## **General Rule:**
